

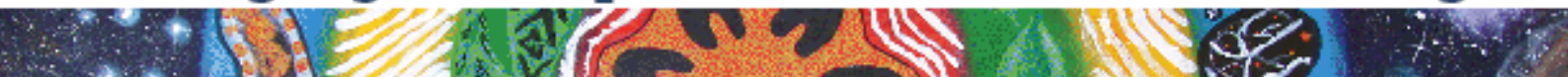

Person-Centred Planning

Person-Centred Planning is an approach that places the student at the centre of goal setting. Students and their families have an opportunity to participate in a ComPASS session followed by regular Transition Meetings to review progress, inform IEPs and work towards a successful transition from school.





Parent Support

The Support@bility group provides parents with an opportunity to network and learn from each other, as well as listen to guest speakers sharing up to date information on topics such as: NDIS, service providers, transition from school to adult life, accessing the community for leisure and recreation and health & well being.

Support@bility sessions are catered events and have proved extremely popular in increasing parent knowledge to make informed choices when their child leaves school. During the year Cyril Jackson ESC hosts several organisations and providers who work within the NDIS realm.

We invite providers such as Disability Employment Services (i.e. Good Sammy's), Australian Disability Enterprises (i.e. Work Power) alongside providers who support School Leavers with Employment Solutions (i.e. Bizlink, Edge, Essential Personnel). Parents gain valuable insight and knowledge about what these services can offer to support their children with their transition from school to life after school.



Therapy on site Provision

Cyril Jackson SC ESC welcomes therapists as partners who add value to our students' long-term goals and support in the transition process from school into life after school. Our therapy agreement process was recently updated to reflect the current Schedule Service Agreements ensuring that all parties are aware of their roles and responsibilities. Parents must initially request that the school considers having their child's therapist deliver therapy during the school day.

Therapists work in partnership with staff by sharing the student's SMART goals, so we are all working together to improve individual student achievement.

The types of therapists vary and include NDIS funding Finding and Keeping a Job or School Leavers Employment Support (SLES) providers to explore work options and assist in developing the discovery process during school.

Developing these collegiate relationships with outside agencies increases the likelihood of our students having a smoother transition at the end of their schooling.

Student Councillors

The student councillors promote student voice in our school community. They work as a team to encourage a sense of belonging, togetherness and respect amongst all students at our school. They oversee school events and fundraising, helping to develop social skills and friendship building amongst peers. They utilise our student notice board to share awareness of community issues, encouraging students to become confident, compassionate and active citizens in the community.

The student councillors also encourage students to recognise and write a student award nomination form for other students who are demonstrating our core school values. Students selected then receive certificates of recognition. This is a wonderful way to acknowledge and promote positive behaviours in our school.

Developing skills outside of the classroom

Cyril Jackson Senior Campus Education Support Centre offers a range of activities for students to develop outside the classroom, these include:

Community Access

Gives opportunities for our students to apply learned skills in a real-life setting.

Sporting Events

Give students a multitude of skills including teamwork, fair play, sportsmanship and resilience.

Swimming Lessons

Allow students to practice their swimming techniques, learn about water safety and have fun ending with a day of games and water play.

School Camp

Our students are supported to step out of their comfort zone to expand their capacity in a variety of ways by participating in adventure activities. We see our students blossom in this environment and encourage attendance as either a day or overnight student.

School Ball

A right of passage for our students in their senior years of schooling and an opportunity to fully integrate with students on our shared site.
